MATINS

“**God is the Lord...**” with its stichoi in Tone 2 followed by the **Troparia**:

The **Kathismata** from the Octoechos, Tone 2. The Theotokion of the first Kathisma is replaced by the Resurrectional Dismissal Theotokion:

All of thy most glorious mysteries are beyond comprehension, O Theotokos; for, thy purity sealed and thy virginity intact, thou art known to be a true Mother, having given birth unto God. Him do thou entreat, that our souls may be saved.
