The **First Kathisma** and **Second Kathisma** are from the Octoechos, Tone 7. The Theotokion of the first Kathisma is replaced by the Resurrectional Dismissal Theotokion of Tone 7:

As thou art the treasury of our resurrection, O all-hymned one, lead up from the pit and abyss of transgression those who trust in thee, for thou who gavest birth to our Salvation hast saved those who are subject to sin. O thou who before giving birth wast Virgin, and during birthgiving wast Virgin, thou remainest a Virgin after giving birth.
