The **First Kathisma** and **Second Kathisma** are from the Octoechos, Tone 8. The verse on “Both now” of the First Kathisma is replaced by the Resurrectional Dismissal Theotokion:

O Good One, Who for our sake wast born of the Virgin, and having endured crucifixion cast down death by death, and as God revealed the resurrection: disdain not that which Thou hast fashioned with Thine own hand. Show forth Thy love for mankind, O Merciful One; accept the Theotokos who gave Thee birth and prayeth for us; and save Thy despairing people, O our Saviour!

#### **Third Kathisma**

Thou didst expose the delusion of those who erred, and didst expound the Scriptures most piously, O hierarch worthy of admiration. Thou didst send forth doctrines sweeter than honey, thus delighting believers’ hearts, and teaching all to adore the one Godhead in Trinity. Thou didst advocate that our Saviour Christ’s humanity, depicted in icons, should receive relative worship. O Theologian Gregory, intercede with Christ our God, that He grant forgiveness of all their transgressions to those who with longing observe thy holy memory.

#### **Glory ... Both now ...**

Come, all ye nations; let us in godliness praise the Mother of Him that created all, and let us cry out: Rejoice, only pure Queen of all the world; fiery throne of Christ Jesus, the Master and King of all; spotless, shining abode of the All-holy Trinity; Father, Son and Spirit’s bright immaculate vessel! Rejoice, thou all-modest Bride who art robed with the brightest sun, O all-hymned Mother of our God. Rejoice, O Theotokos! Rejoice, ever-virgin Mary, who art full of grace! Rejoice, thou infinite gladness of all them that sing thy praise!
