MATINS

“**God is the Lord...**” with its stichoi in Tone 7. Then the **Troparia**:

Tone 7	Troparion of the Resurrection Glory ...	Green Book page 14
Tone 8	Troparion of Saint Chariton the Confessor Both now ...	Sheet
Tone 8	Resurrectional Dismissal Theotokion:	

O Good One, Who for our sake wast born of the Virgin
and, having endured crucifixion, cast down death by death,
and as God revealed the Resurrection:
disdain not that which Thou hast fashioned with Thine own hand.
Show forth Thy love for mankind, O Merciful One;
accept the Theotokos who gave Thee birth and prayeth for us;
and save Thy despairing people, O our Saviour!

The **Kathismata** from the Octoechos, Tone 7. The Theotokion of the first Kathisma is replaced by the Resurrectional Dismissal Theotokion:

As thou art the treasury of our Resurrection, O all-hymned one, lead up from the pit and abyss of transgression those who trust in thee, for thou who gavest birth to our Salvation hast saved those who are subject to sin. O thou who before giving birth wast Virgin, and during birthgiving wast Virgin, thou remainest a Virgin after giving birth.

Polielely is **NOT** sung

The **Hypakoë**, **Anabathmoi** and the **Prokeimenon** with its accompanying stichos are all from the Octoechos, Tone 7

The 5th Eothinon Gospel is chanted from the Holy Table.
