

SUNDAY 17 MAY 2015 – Sunday of the Blind Man

MATINS

Priest: Blessed is our God ...

Reader: Amen.

Priest: Christ is risen from the dead ... (2½ times)

Reader: ... and upon those in the tombs bestowing life!

The Reader then continues the Trisagion Prayers from “Glory to the Father ...”, “All Holy Trinity ...” etc.

Before the Six Psalms, instead of “Glory to God in the highest ...” and “O Lord, open thou my lips ...” sing “Christ is risen from the dead, trampling down death by death; and upon those in the tombs bestowing life.” (3 times)

“**God is the Lord...**” with its stichoi in Tone 5, then the **Apolytikia**:

The **Kathismata** are all from the Pentecostarion for the Sunday of the Blind Man.

Polieleley is **NOT** sung

Troparia of the Resurrection / Evlogetaria are sung Matins booklet page 35

The **Hypakoë**, **Anabathmoi** and the **Prokeimenon** with its accompanying stichos are all from the Octoechos, Tone 5.

The 8th Eothinon Gospel is chanted from the Holy Table

After the Gospel:

“Having beheld the Resurrection of Christ ...” Matins booklet page 44

Psalm 50

Troparia following Psalm 50 Matins booklet page 46

The **Intercession**, followed by the **Great Doxology** with the Troparion “Today is salvation come unto the world ...”

DIVINE LITURGY

Priest: Blessed is the Kingdom ...

Choir: Amen.

Priest: Christ is risen from the dead ... (2½ times)

Choir: ... and upon those in the tombs bestowing life!

TRISAGION is sung as usual

PROKEIMENON Tone 8

Pray and make your vows * before the Lord our God!

v: In Judah God is known; His name is great in Israel!

EPISTLE: Acts 16:16-34 (Begins “In those days ...” instead of “Ye brethren ...”)

ALLELUIA

v: Look upon me and have mercy on me.

v: Direct my steps according to Thy word.

GOSPEL: John 9:1-38

MEGALYNARION

“It is truly meet ...” is replaced by “The Angel cried ...”

COMMUNION HYMN

Receive the Body of Christ, taste the fountain of immortality. Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia!

AFTER COMMUNION

Priest: “O God, save thy people ...”

Choir: “Christ is risen from the dead ...” (x1 instead of “We have seen the True Light ...”)

Priest: “Always, now and ever ...”

Choir: “Let our mouths be filled ...” as usual
