The **Kathismata** from the Octoechos, Tone 1, with the verses on “Both now ...” for the Transfiguration, as follows:

First Kathisma

Thou wast transfigured on Mount Tabor, O Jesus our Lord, and a shining cloud spread out like a tabernacle, completely covering the Apostles with Thy glory. Whereupon they turned their gaze toward the ground, unable to endure to see the radiance of the unapproachable glory of Thy face, O unoriginate Saviour Christ. Our God, who then didst shine Thy light upon them, do Thou also illumine our souls!

Second Kathisma

When transfigured on the mount, O Jesus, Thou didst shine upon Thy divine disciples, John and James and Peter, with the bright and unapproachable glory of Thy divine light. With grace divine didst Thou amaze them, for they heard as the Father’s voice witnessed that Thou art His beloved Son, and they saw also the dread glory of Thy countenance. O Thou Who willest all men’s salvation, grant light to our souls, O Saviour.
