The **Kathismata** are from the Octoechos, Tone 7, with the verse on “Both now” of the Theophany, as follows:

First Kathisma

At Thine Epiphany at the River Jordan, O Christ, at Thy Baptism by the Forerunner, the voice from heaven testified that Thou art the beloved Son. Wherefore, Thou wast shown to be co-eternal with the Father, and the Holy Spirit came down as a dove and alighted on Thee. Enlightened by Him, we cry out: “Glory to God in Trinity!”

Second Kathisma

Tell us, River Jordan, what didst thou see and wast amazed? I saw naked Him whom none can see, and shuddered in fear. And how was I not to shudder at Him and be afraid? The Angels, when they saw Him, also shuddered in awe. And heaven was astonished, and astounded was the earth. The sea recoiled along with all things both visible and invisible. For Christ appeared in the River Jordan, to sanctify the waters.
