Kontakion: Faithful Departed (“With the saints give rest...”)

**DIVINE LITURGY OF ST JOHN CHRYSOSTOM:**

**Typical Antiphons**

**Beatitudes on 6:** Oktoechos Tone 5

**Eisodikon:** Come, let us worship, and fall down before Christ. Save us, O Son of God, who art wondrous in the saints; who sing to thee: Alleluia.

**After the entrance:**

Tropar All Saints (“Apostles, martyrs, and prophets...”)

Tropar Faithful Departed (“Remember the souls of thy servants, O Lord...”)

Glory...

Kondak Faithful Departed (“With the saints...”)

Both now...

Theotokion: We have thee as a wall and haven...

**Prokeimenon, Tone 6:** Be glad in the Lord and rejoice, ye righteous : and be joyful, all ye that are upright of heart.

*vs.* Blessed are they whose transgressions are forgiven.

**And in the same tone:** Their souls shall dwell in prosperity.

**The Apostle:** Hebrews 3:12-16; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-17

**Alleluia: Tone 4:** The righteous cried, and the Lord heard them; and he delivered them out of all their tribulations.

*vs.* Many are the tribulations of the righteous; and the Lord shall deliver them out of them all.

**And in the sixth tone:** Blessed are they whom thou hast chosen and hast taken to thyself, O Lord. Their memory is from generation to generation.

**The Holy Gospel:** St Mark 1:35-44; St John 5:24-30

**Megalynarion:** Meet it is, in truth...

**Koinonikon:** Rejoice in the Lord, O ye righteous; praise befits the just. Alleluia.

Blessed are they whom thou has chosen and taken to thyself, O Lord; their memory is from generation to generation. Alleluia.
