Both now... Resurrectional Theotokion Tone 8: *O unwedded Virgin...*

St Simeon and the Trisagion Prayers

Apolytikia: Resurrection Tone 4 (Vespers folder): *Having heard the radiant proclamation ...*

Gloria... Ven Athanasius Tone 3 (Menaion pg 62): *The ranks of the angels marvelled ...*

Both now... Resurrectional Theotokion Tone 3 (Vespers folder): *We praise thee, O virgin Theotokos...*

Vespers dismissal (vespers folder)

Deacon: Wisdom!

Choir: Father, bless!

Priest: He who is...

Choir: Amen. Establish, etc...
