The First Kathisma and Second Kathisma from the Octoechos, Tone 8. The verses on “Both now” are replaced by those of the Feast:

First Kathisma

O pure Virgin, we sing the praise of thy holy Protection, which, in thy goodness and motherly compassion, at every moment protecteth and watcheth over us, whom thou hast declared to be thy lot and chosen part. Guard us also, O Sovereign Lady, in future need!

Second Kathisma

Venerable Andrew was amazed when in the church of Vlachernae he saw thee unfolding for us thy godly Robe, which is guarded there, O pure Maiden, and revealeth to all the grace of thy protection, through which thou dost protect and save us from every affliction.

Third Kathisma

O Holy Maiden, as thou dost unfold each day thy holy and wondrous Protection, which the cloud in the Law prefigured, thou dost enfold thy race that looketh intently for thy goodness, and ever awaiteth the help that thou givest, O Mother of God. At all times turn the mad rage of enemies away from us who sing the praise of the greatness of thy wonders; as thou dost intercede with thy Son and God to grant forgiveness of sins to us who celebrate with love thine all-radiant Protection.
