Thou, who didst call Thy mother blessed, camest of Thine own will to the Passion. For having shone on the Cross, desiring to recall Adam, Thou didst say to the angels: “Rejoice with me, for the lost coin has been found.” O Thou who hast wisely ordered all things, O our God, glory to Thee.
