Afterfeast of the Ascension • Holy Fathers of the First Ecumenical Council

MATINS

At the beginning:

Priest: Blessed is our God ...

Reader: Amen.

“Glory to Thee our God ...” and “O Heavenly King ...” are **omitted**: the Trisagion Prayers continue immediately from “Holy God ...”

Before the Six Psalms:

“Glory to God in the highest ...” and “O Lord, open Thou my lips ...” are read as usual.

“**God is the Lord...**” with its stichoi in Tone 6 followed by the **Troparia**:

The 10th Eothinon Gospel is read from the Holy Table.

PROKEIMENON Tone 4

Blessed art Thou, O Lord God of our fathers, * and praised and glorified is Thy Name forever!
v: For Thou art just in all that Thou hast done for us!

EPISTLE: Acts 20:16-18, 28-36 (Begins “In those days ...” instead of “Ye brethren ...”)

ALLELUIA

v: The Lord, the God of gods, speaks and summons the earth from the rising of the sun to its setting.

v: Gather to Me, My venerable ones, who made a covenant with Me by sacrifice!

GOSPEL: John 17:1-13

MEGALYNARION

Instead of “It is truly meet ...”

COMMUNION HYMNS

Praise the Lord from the heavens, praise Him in the highest! Rejoice in the Lord, O ye righteous; praise befits the upright! Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia!

AFTER COMMUNION

Instead of “We have seen the True Light ...” sing the Troparion of the Ascension (Green Book page 103)
