The mystery hidden from before the ages and unknown even to the angels, through thee, O Theotokos, hath been revealed to those on earth: God incarnate in unconfused union, Who willingly accepted the Cross for our sake, and thereby raising up the first-formed man, hath saved our souls from death.

Third Kathisma for Saint John Chrysostom

Watered by thy golden words, the Church doth give all men to drink refreshing waters, bright as gold; and she healeth the ills of all who praise thee, O all-blessed Chrysostom.

Glory ...

Neither an unlawful synod’s unjust enmity, nor the hatred and spite of an Empress frenzied with rage, could quench thy virtues, O all-lauded Father Chrysostom. But in the fire of thy trials thou wast assayed like pure gold, and now entreatest without ceasing the Holy Trinity, for Whose sake thou didst contend with burning spirit.

Both now ...

I implore thee to show thy protection and speedy help and mercy to me, O most pure Maid; and to becalm every stormy wave of vain and futile thoughts, and to resurrect my fallen soul, O blest Theotokos. For I know, yea, I know, O blest Virgin, that thou canst do whatsoever thou wilt!
