The **Kathismata** from the Octoechos, Tone 1, with the verses on “Both now ...” for the Transfiguration, as follows:

#### **First Kathisma**

Thou wast transfigured on Mount Tabor, showing thus the transformation that mortal men shall with Thy glory undergo at Thy fearful Second Coming, O our Saviour. Moses and Elijah conversed with Thee. And Thou didst call together there three of Thy disciples, who gazed upon Thy glory, O Master, and were dazzled by Thy refulgent light. O Lord, who then didst shine Thy light upon them, do Thou also illumine our souls!

#### **Second Kathisma**

Thou wast transfigured on Mount Tabor, O Jesus our Lord, and a shining cloud spread out like a tabernacle, completely covering the Apostles with Thy glory. Whereupon they turned their gaze toward the ground, unable to endure to see the radiance of the unapproachable glory of Thy face, O unoriginate Saviour Christ. O our God, who then didst shine Thy light upon them, do Thou also illumine our souls!

**PROKEIMENON** Tone 4

O Lord, how manifold are Thy works; \* in wisdom hast Thou made them all!

**ALLELUIA**

v: God gives vengeance to me, and subdues people under me.  
v: He magnifies the salvation of the king, and deals mercifully with David, His anointed and his seed forever.  
v: The heavens are Thine; the earth also is Thine.

**MEGALYNARION**
