First Kathisma

After thou didst fall asleep, O all-pure one, thou didst rise in body and in soul into the heavens' heights, whence thy cherished Son did descend in Godly manner. That impious man, who dared to approach thy most sacred bier to upset it monstrously, was by divine justice struck down. And therefore with the Angel we cry to thee: Rejoice, O Lady full of grace.

Second Kathisma

Thou hast given up thy soul into the hands of thy Creator and thy God, Who from thee had become man for our sake; He transported thee from earth to immortal life. With reverence, therefore, we piously call thee blessed, who alone art pure, untouched by any stain. And as is right, we all confess that thou art truly the Theotokos. And we cry: Pray to Christ, to Whom thou hast been translated, to grant our souls His salvation.
