**First Kathisma**

O virgins, sing your praises, and likewise all you mothers; you priests, pronounce our blessings, and you people now glorify the immaculate Theotokos; for she was offered as an infant in the Temple of the Law, being herself the Holy Temple of the Lord. And as we thus joyously observe this spiritual feast, let us cry out: “Rejoice, holy Virgin, the glory of mankind.”

**Second Kathisma**

O Prophet David, go ahead into the Temple of God, and joyfully receive therein the virgin Maiden, our Queen, addressing her thus: “O holy Lady, enter the holy Temple of the King; enter, O Maid whose glory is perceived though hidden. From thee will gush forth Christ the Light as honey and milk for all.”
