The **Kathismata** from the Octoechos, Tone 6. The Theotokion of the first Kathisma is replaced by the Resurrectional Dismissal Theotokion:

Thou who didst call Thy mother blessed camest of Thine own will to the Passion. For having shone on the Cross, desiring to recall Adam, Thou didst say to the angels: “Rejoice with me, for the lost coin has been found.” O Thou who hast wisely ordered all things, O our God, glory to Thee.
