Sunday of the Samaritan Woman and Afterfeast of Mid-Pentecost

MATINS

At the beginning:

Priest: Blessed is our God ...

Reader: Amen.

Priest: Christ is risen from the dead ... (2½ times)

Reader: ... and upon those in the tombs bestowing life!

The Trisagion Prayers continue from “Glory to the Father ...”, “All Holy Trinity ...” etc.

Before the Six Psalms, instead of “Glory to God in the highest ...” and “O Lord, open Thou my lips ...” sing “Christ is risen from the dead, trampling down death by death; and upon those in the tombs bestowing life.” (3 times)

“**God is the Lord...**” with its stichoi in Tone 4, then the **Troparia**:

PROKEIMENON Tone 3

Sing praises to our God, sing praises! * Sing praises to our King, sing praises!

v: Clap your hands, all peoples! Shout to God with loud songs of joy!

EPISTLE: Acts 11:19-30 (Begins “In those days ...” instead of “Ye brethren ...”)

ALLELUIA

v: Go forth and prosper and reign, because of truth and meekness and righteousness.

v: For Thou lovest righteousness and hatest iniquity.

GOSPEL: John 4:5-42

MEGALYNARION

Instead of “It is truly meet ...”: “The Angel cried ...” Sheet **OR** Green Book page 78 or 79

COMMUNION HYMN

Receive the Body of Christ, taste the fountain of immortality. Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia!

AFTER COMMUNION

Priest: “O God, save thy people ...”

Choir: “Christ is risen from the dead ...” (x1 instead of “We have seen the True Light ...”)

Priest: “Always, now and ever ...”

Choir: “Let our mouths be filled ...” as usual
