MATINS

“**God is the Lord...**” with its stichoi in Tone 7 followed by the **Troparia**:

The **First Kathisma** and **Second Kathisma** (‘Sessional hymns’) from the Festal Menaion, page 478.

Polieley is sung Matins booklet page 33

The **Magnification** is sung Festal Menaion page 479
The first ‘We magnify ...’ is sung by the priest, then repeated by the choir.

The Evlogetaria (“Blessed art Thou, O Lord”) are **NOT** sung

The **Third Kathisma** (‘Sessional hymn’) from the Festal Menaion, page 479.

Instead of the Hypakoë, the **Anabathmoi** (“From my youth up”) Sheet

Prokeimenon from the Festal Menaion, page 480.

The **Gospel** is read *from the Holy Doors*.

After the Gospel:

“Having beheld the Resurrection of Christ ...” is **NOT** sung.

Psalm 50 is read, but there is *no veneration of the Gospel Book*.

FESTAL ANTIPHONS

White Book Page 115ff

ENTRANCE HYMN

The Introit of the Little Entrance on page 117 of the White Book is not used.

After “Wisdom! Stand upright!” intone:

For with Thee is the fountain of life, O Lord; and in Thy light shall we see light.

Then repeat the refrain of the Second Antiphon (White Book page 116):

O Son of God who wast transfigured on the mount, save us who sing to Thee: Alleluia!

TRISAGION (“Holy God ...”) as usual

PROKEIMENON Tone 4

O Lord, how manifold art Thy works; in wisdom hast Thou made them all!

v: Bless the Lord, O my soul! O Lord, my God, Thou art very great!

EPISTLE: 2 Peter 1:10-19

ALLELUIA

v: The heavens art Thine; the earth also is Thine.

v: Blessed are the people who know the sound of joy!

GOSPEL: Matthew 17:1-9

MEGALYNARION

Instead of “Meet it is in truth ...”

COMMUNION HYMN

O Lord, we will walk in the light of Thy countenance, and will exult in Thy name forever.

Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia.

AFTER COMMUNION

Instead of “We have seen the True Light”, the Troparion of the Transfiguration (White Book page 118)

After the Prayer behind the Ambon, grapes are blessed, to be distributed with the Antidoron. After the blessing, the Liturgy continues as usual from “Blessed be the Name of the Lord ...”
