#### **First Kathisma**

And Simeon, having been made the confidant to these mysteries, knew Him as God appearing in the flesh. Wherefore, he kissed Him, for He is Life. And the elder cried with joy, saying: Lettest thou me depart, for I have beheld Thee, O Life of all.

#### **Second Kathisma**

He that is with the Father on the holy throne came down to earth, was born of the Virgin, became a babe, and is unbounded in time. And Simeon, having carried Him in his arms, shouted with joy, saying: Now lettest Thou thy servant, O compassionate One, depart; for Thou hast gladdened him.
