MATINS

Usual beginning, including “O Heavenly King ...”

“**God is the Lord...**” with its stichoi in Tone 8 followed by the **Troparion**:

Tone 8 Troparion of Pentecost (twice) Green Book page 113

Glory ... Both now ...

Tone 8 Troparion of Pentecost (once) Green Book page 113

The **Kathismata** of Pentecost from the Pentecostarion.

Polieley is sung

MAGNIFICATION

Priest: We magnify, we magnify Thee, O Christ the Giver of Life. And we honour Thine All-Holy Spirit, Whom Thou dost send from the Father to Thy divine disciples.

Choir: We magnify ...

Reader: The heavens are telling the glory of God, and the firmament proclaims His handiwork.

Choir: We magnify ...

Reader: And all their hosts by the Spirit of His mouth.

Choir: We magnify ...

Reader: Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Choir: We magnify ...

Reader: Both now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Choir: We magnify ...

Evlogetaria (“Blessed art Thou, O Lord ...”) are **NOT** sung.

Instead of the Hypakoë, the **Anabathmoi** (“From my youth up ...”)

Sheet

The **Prokeimenon** of Pentecost from the Pentecostarion.

The 9th Eothinon Gospel is read *from the Holy Doors*.

AFTER THE GOSPEL

“Having beheld the Resurrection of Christ ...” is **NOT** sung.

Psalm 50 is read, but there is *no veneration of the Gospel Book*.

Troparia following Psalm 50 are sung, but “Jesus rose from the grave ...” is replaced by “O Heavenly King ...” (Sheet)

The Intercession, followed by the Great Doxology and the Troparion of the Feast (Green Book page 113)

DIVINE LITURGY

FESTAL ANTIPHONS of Pentecost

Green Book Page 110ff

ENTRANCE HYMN

Reader intones: Be exalted, O Lord, in Thy strength! We will sing and praise Thy power!

Then repeat: O Gracious Comforter, save us who sing to Thee: Alleluia! (Green Book page 111)

TROPARION & KONTAKION

INSTEAD OF THE TRISAGION

As many as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. Alleluia!

PROKEIMENON Tone 8

Their proclamation has gone out into all the earth * and their words to the ends of the universe!

v: The heavens are telling the glory of God; and the firmament proclaims His handiwork.

EPISTLE: Acts 2:1-11 (NB: **Not** introduced with “In those days” or “Ye brethren”)

ALLELUIA

v: By the Word of the Lord the heavens were made; and all their host by the Spirit of His mouth.

v: The Lord looked down from heaven, and saw all the sons of men.

GOSPEL: John 7:37-52; 8:12

MEGALYNARION

Instead of “It is truly meet ...”

COMMUNION HYMN

Let Thy good Spirit lead me forth into the land of righteousness! Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia!

AFTER COMMUNION

Priest: “O God, save Thy people ...”

Choir: Troparion of Pentecost

Priest: “Always, now and ever ...”

Choir: “Let our mouths be filled ...” as usual
