**Reader:** O Heavenly King... *and the rest of the Trisagion Prayers, through ...* but deliver us from the evil one.

**Choir:** Amen.

**Reader:** Lord, have mercy 12X. Glory be... now and ever... Amen.

Come, let us worship God our King.

Come, let us worship Christ, our King and our God.

Come, let us worship and fall down before Christ Himself, our King and our God.

*Psalm 103 is read in its entirety*

*The hand censer is lit.*

**Lord, I call upon thee** on 10, tone 5: *Note: we chant all the lamplighting psalms*

**Glory...** John the Faster Tone 4: (Sheet)

**Both now...** Resurrectional Theotokion Tone 4 (Vespers folder)
