The **Kathismata** are from the Octoechos, Tone 8, with the verses on “Both now ...” of the after-feast of Theophany, as follows:

First Kathisma

By Thine Epiphany in the Jordan, O Christ, and by Thy baptism by the Forerunner, it was testified of Thee that Thou art the beloved Son. Wherefore, Thou wast shown to be co-eternal with the Father, and the Holy Spirit descended upon Thee. In Him we are illumined and cry out, “Glory to God in three Persons.”

Second Kathisma

Tell us, Jordan River, what didst thou see, and why wast thou astonished? And he answered, saying, “I saw naked Him whom none can see, and I shuddered in fear. And how was I not to shudder at Him and be afraid?” The Angels, when they saw Him also shuddered in awe. And heaven was astonished, and astounded was the earth. The sea recoiled along with all things both visible and invisible. For Christ appeared in the River Jordan, to sanctify the waters.

Polieley is **NOT** sung
