MATINS

The **First Kathisma** and **Second Kathisma** are from the Octoechos, Tone 2. In the First Kathisma, the Theotokion is replaced by the Resurrectional Dismissal Theotokion of Tone 2:

All of thy most glorious mysteries are beyond comprehension, O Theotokos; for, thy purity sealed and thy virginity intact, thou art known to be a true Mother, having given birth unto God. Him do thou entreat, that our souls may be saved.

Third Kathisma for Saint John Chrysostom

By divine decree, O holy one, thou didst worthily become the shepherd of Christ’s flock, and thou didst drive transgressors thence like wolves with thy words as a slingshot. Thou didst unsparingly rebuke the lawbreakers, and by them, for envy’s sake, O wondrous Chrysostom, thou wast sent far off. With a steadfast mind, O wise Father, thou didst travel a long road, and thou didst die thereon. But thou art come back unto thine own city and bestowest divine gifts.

Glory ... Both now ...

Joseph was amazed to see that which transcended nature’s bounds, for without seed, O Maiden, thou didst both conceive and bear a Child. And he remembered the blossoming rod of Aaron, the dew upon the fleece, and the bush that remained unconsumed by fire, though it was all aflame. Thus, thy protector and betrothed cried, as he bore witness before the priests: The Virgin beareth, and after childbirth remaineth a Virgin still.

Polielely is sung

Troparia of the Resurrection / Evlogetaria are sung

The **Hypakoë**, **Anabathmoi** and the **Prokeimenon** with its accompanying stichos are all from the Octoechos Tone 2.

The Great Doxology followed by the Troparion: “Rising from the Tomb ...”

PROKEIMENON Tone 2

The Lord is my strength and my song. * He has become my salvation.

v: The Lord has chastened me sorely, but He has not given me over to death.

PROKEIMENON Tone 1

My mouth shall speak wisdom, * and the meditation of my heart shall be understanding.

EPISTLE: 1 Timothy 4:9-15 (Begins “Child Timothy”) & Hebrews 7:26-8:2 (“Ye brethren”)

ALLELUIA

v: May the Lord hear thee in the day of trouble! May the Name of the God of Jacob protect thee!

v: O Lord, save the King, and hear us on the day when we call upon Thee!

v: The mouth of the righteous shall proclaim wisdom, and his tongue shall speak of judgment.
