9th Sunday after Pentecost ♦ Afterfeast of the Dormition of the Theotokos

MATINS

“God is the Lord...” with its stichoi in Tone 8. Then the **Troparia**:

The **Kathismata** from the Octoechos, Tone 8, with the verses on “Both now ...” of the Dormition, as follows:

First Kathisma

Shout, O David, and declare: what is this present feast? And he replies: “Today has Christ translated unto the mansions above her from whom He was born without seed, and whom I have extolled in the Book of the Psalms as daughter, child of God and virgin.” Wherefore do mothers, daughters, and brides of Christ shout in joy: “Rejoice, O thou who hast been translated to the royal courts on high!”

Second Kathisma

The honourable choir of the wise Apostles was wondrously convened, O all-praised Theotokos, to bury with dignity thine immaculate, holy body. And with them the hosts of Angels in admiration and solemnity extolled with hymns thine Assumption, which we celebrate in faith.

Polieley is sung

The **Evlogetaria** are sung

The **Hypakoë**, **Anabathmoi** and the **Prokeimenon** with its accompanying stichos are all from the Octoechos, Tone 8.

The 9th Eothinon Gospel is read from the Holy Table.

“Having beheld the Resurrection of Christ ...”

Psalm 50

Troparia following Psalm 50

The Intercession

The **Great Doxology** and the Troparion “Rising from the Tomb ...”

DIVINE LITURGY

FIRST AND SECOND ANTIPHONS: Typical Psalms, as usual

INSTEAD OF THE BEATITUDES

The following verses with the Troparion of the Dormition (White Book page 128):

v: My heart is ready, O God, my heart is ready; I will sing and give praise in my glory. **Troparion**

v: To the saints who are on His earth, in them the Lord has magnified all His will. **Troparion**

v: I will take the cup of salvation, and call on the name of the Lord. **Troparion**

ENTRANCE HYMN

O come, let us worship and fall down before Christ. O Son of God, who art risen from the dead, save us who sing to Thee: Alleluia!

My soul doth magnify the Lord * and my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Saviour.

EPISTLE: 1 Corinthians 3:9-17

ALLELUIA

v: Come let us rejoice in the Lord! Let us make a joyful noise to God our Saviour!

v: Let us come before His face with thanksgiving; let us make a joyful noise to Him with psalms!

v: Arise, O Lord, and go to Thy resting place, Thou and the ark of Thy sanctification!
