First Kathisma

The nourisher of our Life, now an infant in body, the offspring of the just Joachim and Anna, is offered to God today in the holy Sanctuary, being blessed therein by the priest Zacharias. Therefore let us all, with faith, proclaim that she is blessed, for she is the Mother of the Lord.

Second Kathisma

Thou wast consecrated unto God before thy conception; being born on earth, thou art now offered to Him as a gift, O pure one, fulfilling thy parents’ promise. In purity returned unto the divine Temple from thine infancy, with lamps brightly shining, in truth thou art thyself a divine temple and a vessel of the divine unapproachable Light. How truly great is thy sacred entrance, O only ever-virgin Bride of God!
