The **Kathismata** from the Octoechos, Tone 4. In the First Antiphon, the verse on “Both now” is replaced by the Resurrectional Dismissal Theotokion of Tone 4:

The mystery hidden from before the ages and unknown even to the angels, through thee, O Theotokos, hath been revealed to those on earth: God incarnate in unconfused union, Who willingly accepted the Cross for our sake, and thereby raising up the first-formed man, hath saved our souls from death.

**Troparia of the Resurrection / Evlogetaria** are sung

The **Hypakoë**, **Anabathmoi** and the **Prokeimenon** with its accompanying stichos are all from the Octoechos Tone 4.
