Verses on Lord I have called

On 6: If Thou shouldst mark iniquities, Lord, O Lord, who shall stand?
For with Thee is propitiation.

and who has now become a babe sub- ject to the Law.

This is He who spoke through the Law:

this is He whose voice was heard in the pro - phets,

who for our sakes has taken flesh and has saved man.'

On 3: For with the Lord there is mercy, and with Him is plenteous redemption; and He shall deliver Israel out of all his iniquities.

On 2: O praise the Lord, all ye nations; praise Him, all ye peoples.

Come, and with divine songs let us also go to meet Christ

and let us receive Him whose salvation Si- me- on saw.

This is He whom Da- vid an- nounced:

this is He whose words the pro- phets ut- tered,

who for our sakes has taken flesh and speaks to us in the Law.

Let us wor- ship Him.

On 1: For He hath made His mercy to prevail over us,
and the truth of the Lord remaineth forever.
