The **Kathismata** are from the Octoechos, Tone 1, with the verse on “Both now” of the Feast, as follows:

#### **First Kathisma**

Let the choir of angels be amazed at this wonder, and let us mortal men raise our voices in song, beholding the ineffable condescension of God. Aged arms now embrace Him before whom the powers of heaven tremble, He who alone loves mankind.

#### **Second Kathisma**

He who is with the Father upon the holy throne, coming to earth is born of a Virgin; and He who is uncircumscribed by time becomes a babe. Simeon received Him in his arms and said rejoicing: “Now, O merciful Lord, let me depart in peace, for Thou hast made glad Thy servant.”

**Polieleley** is sung.

**Troparia of the Resurrection / Evlogetaria** are sung.

The **Hypakoë**, **Anabathmoi** and the **Prokeimenon** with its accompanying stichos are all from the Octoechos Tone 1.

**Gospel:** The 1<sup>st</sup> Eothinon Gospel is read from the Holy Table.

#### **After the Gospel:**

“Having beheld the Resurrection of Christ ...” and Psalm 50, as usual. Then:

**Tone 8:** Glory... “Open to me the gates of repentance ...”

**Tone 8:** Both now... “Lead me on the paths of salvation ...”

**Tone 6:** “Have mercy on me, O God ...”

**Tone 6:** “When I think of the many evil things I have done ...”

#### PROKEIMENON Tone 3

My soul doth magnify the Lord \* and my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Saviour.

**EPISTLE:** 2 Timothy 3:10-15

#### ALLELUIA

v: God gives vengeance to me, and subdues people under me.

v: He magnifies the salvation of the king, and deals mercifully with David, His anointed and his seed forever.

v: Lord, now lettest Thou Thy servant depart in peace, according to Thy word; for mine eyes have seen Thy salvation.

**GOSPEL:** Luke 18:10-14

#### MEGALYNARION

Instead of “It is truly meet” / “Meet it is in truth”
