The **Kathismata** from the Octoechos, Tone 6. In the First Kathisma, the verse on “Both now” is replaced by the Resurrectional Dismissal Theotokion of Tone 6:

Thou who didst call Thy mother blessed camest of Thine own will to the Passion. For having shone on the Cross, desiring to recall Adam Thou didst say to the angels: “Rejoice with me, for the lost coin has been found.” O Thou who hast wisely ordered all things, O our God, glory to Thee!

Troparia of the Resurrection / Evlogetaria

The **Hypakoë**, **Anabathmoi** and the **Prokeimenon** with its accompanying stichos are all from the Octoechos, Tone 6.

The 6th Eothinon Gospel is read from the Holy Table.
